What makes your university unique?

-At the University of Oregon, you'll be welcomed into a community of student and faculty scholars who embrace new ideas and the differences among us. Do you require TOEFL or IELTS scores?

- One test for English Proficiency is required. TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, and ACT are acceptable. A sufficient ACT or SAT score waives the TOEFL or IELTS requirement. (Same as NU)
- ACT/SAT required for most international scholarships

What is your average/minimum GPA?

-University of Oregon also evaluates students on a holistic basis for admission to the University. Admission to competitive programs such as Architecture and the Clark Honor's College require higher GPAs.

What is the minimum AP classes required?

-AP classes are not required for admission but students will get advanced credit for results 3-5.

What is the minimum and/or average SAT/ACT score?

-Nebraska evaluates students on a holistic basis for admission to the University. The average ACT for all incoming students is 25 (1200 SAT). Applicants to competitive programs in Engineering and Architecture must score well above average.

What is the average class size?

-median class size is 20; student-faculty ratio is 17:1

What is the yearly cost for international students?

-Approx. \$55,000.00 USD. This includes tuition, fees, housing accommodations, meals, textbooks, and other estimated costs.

Do you offer international students scholarships?

-The UO offers merit-based and need-based scholarships that range from \$1,000 USD to \$33,000 USD per year. These scholarships are renewed each year for up to 4 years.

-Students are automatically considered for scholarships after gaining admission. There are additional scholarships available by application.
